Bleeding Tissue Paper Postcards

Materials:

- White crayon
- Bleeding tissue paper squares
- Watercolor postcard
- Spritzer bottle

Not included:

- Water
- Paper towel/old towel

Instructions:

- 1. Draw a pattern on the postcard with the white crayon. Do something geometric or organic.
- Trace over your drawing several times with the white crayon, pressing hard. You want the wax layer to be thick.
- 3. Place the postcard on a couple paper towels or one old towel, and fill the spritzer bottle with water.
- 4. Spray the postcard with water until it starts to bow a little
- Place the bleeding tissue paper squares on the postcard, getting the edges of the tissue paper as close together as possible without overlapping too much.
- 6. Spray the postcard and tissue paper with the water a second time.
- 7. Let it dry for 30 min to an hour.
- 8. Remove the dried tissue paper.

Tip: if you aren't sure what to draw, google nature patterns or geometric patterns.
