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ADULT TAKE & MAKE: CORK SAILBOATS INSTRUCTIONS

You will need:

- 7 wine corks
- Cotton scrap fabric
- Two sticks or a small branch (approx. 8" long)
- Twine or string
- Hot glue gun
- Scissors
- Optional decorations like ribbons or stickers

Step 1: Make the base of the sailboat by hot-gluing two sets of three corks together along the sides.

Step 2: Hot glue all 7 corks together. The 7th cork should be at the front. Use small dots of hot glue! Wrap the corks with twine or decorative string.

Step 3: Hot-glue the two sticks together that will support the "sail." See the photo under Step 5 for an example of where to glue the sticks. Wrap them with string or twine for extra support if you'd like.

Step 4: Lay the sticks for the sail on your fabric to use as a template. Use a straight edge or ruler to draw a line from the top of your stick to the corner, forming a triangular sail. Cut out your fabric sail using sharp scissors.

Step 5: Hot glue your stick to the cork base first, then add the fabric sail. Glue the fabric to the bottom stick, but just tack it at the top so it looks open at the center. Decorate with a colorful string at the top or add a tiny flag or ribbon (optional).
