
Terrarium Hanger Instructions

How to tie a loop knot:




How to tie a pretzel knot:



Instructions:

1. Place all 6 strings together, and fold them about 4 inches from the end. Tie a loop knot, which will create the loop for hanging the terrarium.

- Tape the six strings to the edge of the table about 2 feet down from the loop knot to hold everything in place.
- 3. String a single bead onto all 6 strings
- 4. Separate the 6 strings into 3 sets of 2 strings.
- Tie a set of 2 strings with a pretzel knot about an arms length from the loop knot.
 The two strings should be tied together now.
- 6. Repeat step 5 with the other 2 pairs of string. You want them to be about equal distance from the top loop.
- 7. Under the pretzel knots, separate the string pairs.
- Tie a string of one pair to a string from the other pair using a pretzel knot.
 Repeat the step until all the string pairs are recombined, creating a ring of knots.

- 9. About an inch to an inch and a half down from the last pretzel knot, recombine all six strings, and tie them together with a pretzel knot.
- 10. Place planter glob in the center of the string basket at a 45 degree angle
- 11. Slide the beed down the cords at the top until it is just above the globe, securing it in place.
