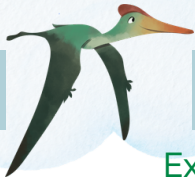


SUMMER READING KICKOFF PARTY!

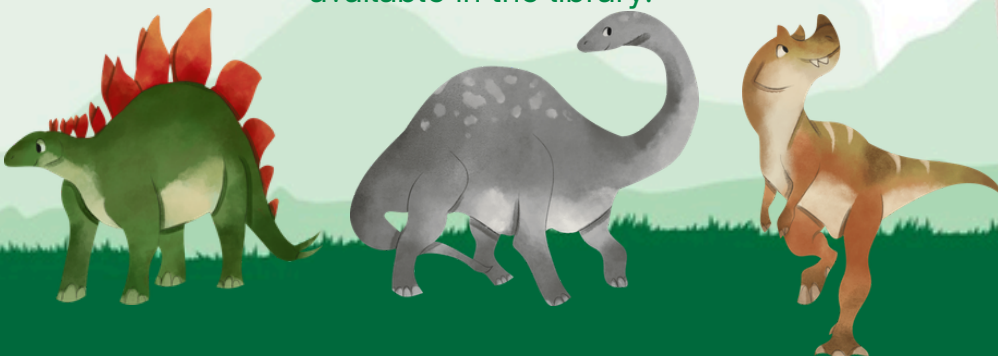

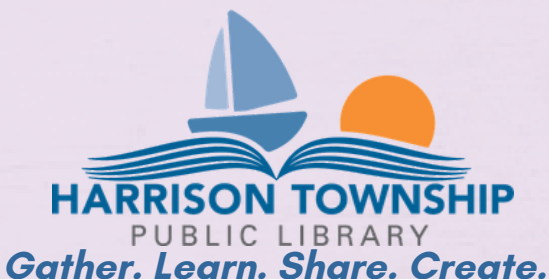
