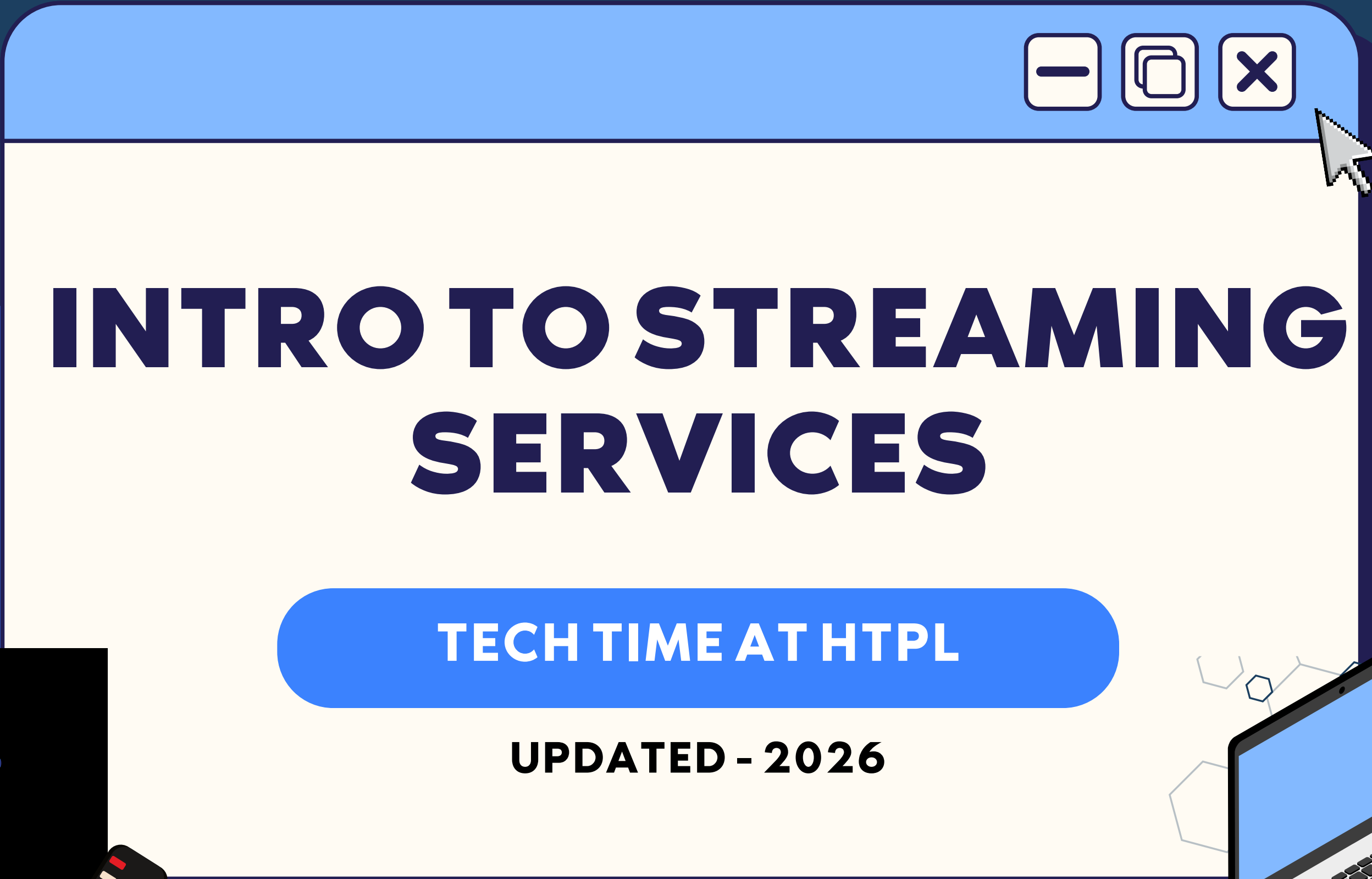
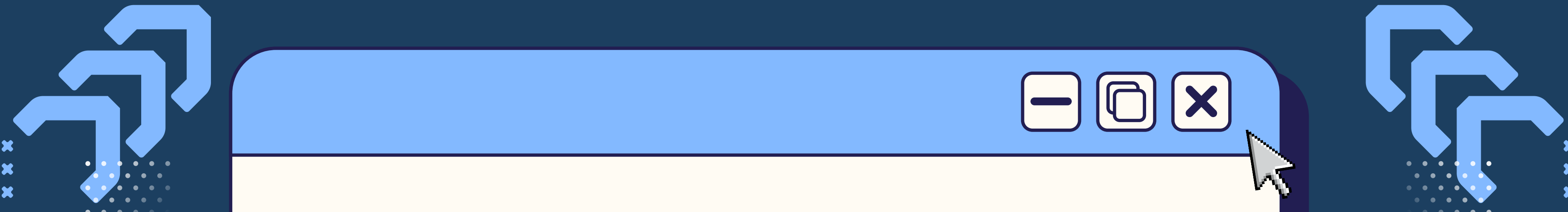
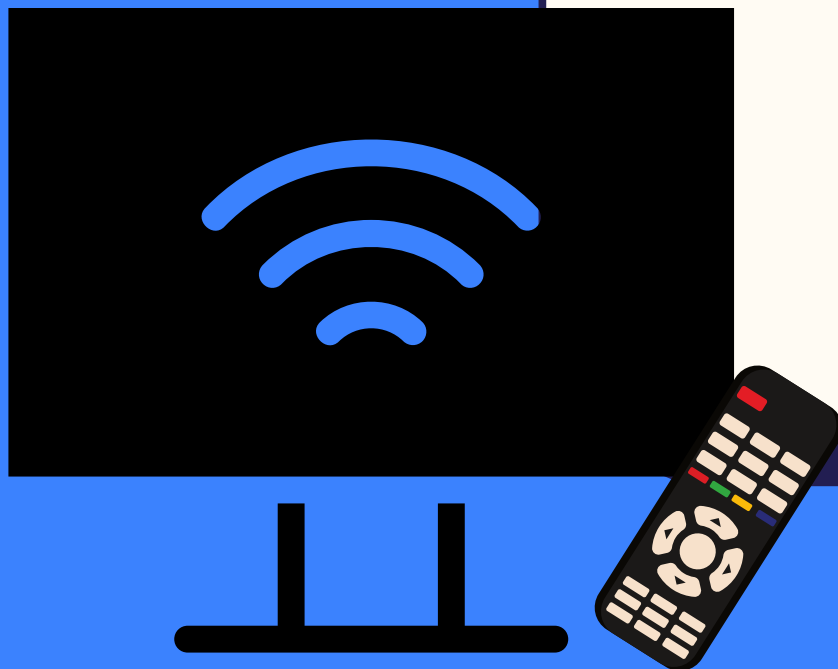

WHAT ARE STREAMING SERVICES?

- **Streaming:** Television, movies, & original programming delivered through an Internet connection
- Main ways to access streaming content: through a device, smart TV, or computer
- Pay a monthly rate for streaming services without signing up for long-term contracts

BEFORE YOU START...

Cutting the cord is not for everyone but you'll be surprised by how much is available to stream at a significantly lower cost than cable.

There is no one "right way" to start streaming. You have to figure out what you want to watch and piece together the streaming combination that works for you.

Have your email and password on hand for creating accounts for the streaming services.

Internet Requirements
Make sure your internet speed is high enough to stream. More information on the next slide.

INTERNET REQUIREMENTS

- Make sure your Internet speed is fast enough to stream.
- 25-40Mbps is recommended for households with multiple streaming users and heavy use streamers.
- 40+Mbps is for really high use users. Online gaming, multiple streams, large downloads & uploads.

TV/DEVICE REQUIREMENTS



- If planning to use a TV to stream, you will need one with access to internet.
- Many modern TVs are “Smart TVs” – you can download apps, customize viewing, etc.
- Popular stores like Walmart will have ROKU TVs and Amazon Fire television sets. Samsung, Vizio, LG, and more have built-in access to streaming services.
- There are also devices that you can purchase and plug into your TV’s HDMI port.
- You can use your smartphone to download streaming service apps and watch on the go.

AVAILABLE DEVICES

- Do some research before you purchase, or consult with a professional at a tech store or Best Buy. What are your streaming needs?
- Stick devices are a cheaper option with comparable functions.
- Table top devices add additional ports and some improved features.

Roku

Lots of different options, consider the Premiere+ or Ultra for 4K & HDR streaming.

Amazon Fire TV

Good for Amazon Prime members. "Smart TV."

Amazon Fire TV Stick

Plugs into your TV and allows you to access streaming services.

Google Chromecast

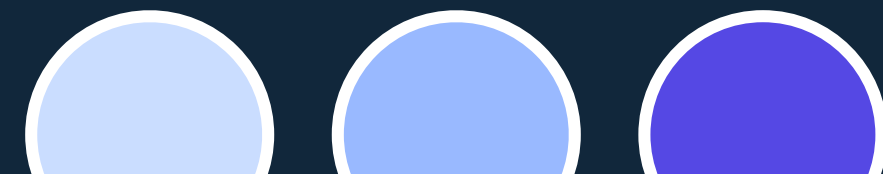
Good for smartphone and tablet device-centric users.

Apple TV

If you already love Apple products, you'll love Apple TV.

PlayStation 4 + XBOX One

If you already have a newer gaming console, you can usually use those for streaming content.

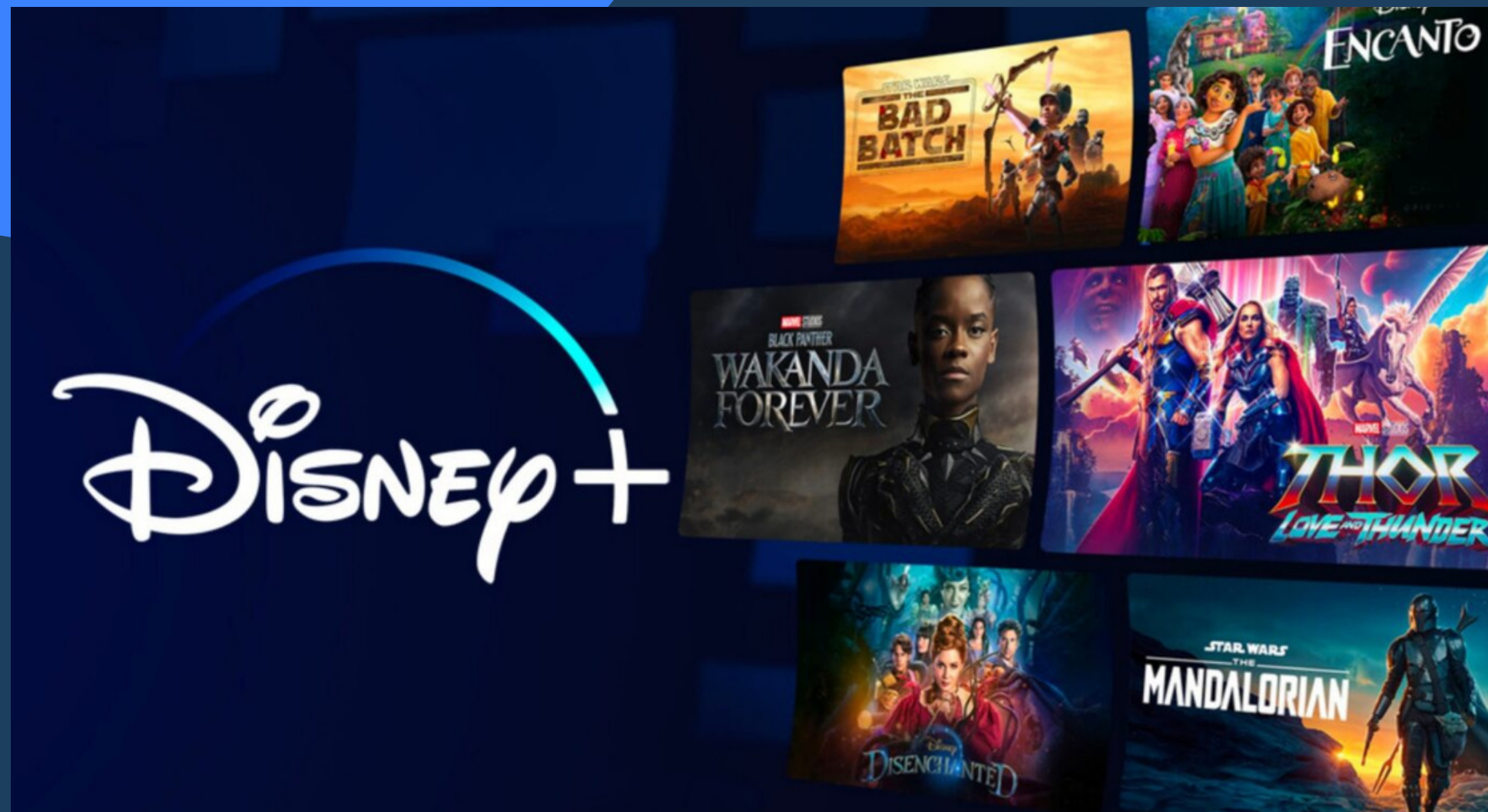
APPLE TV+



Notable titles: Ted Lasso, Severance, Silo, Slow Horses, Lessons in Chemistry, Black Bird, Dickinson

- Selection of film & TV only available on the service (“Apple Originals”)
- 1 subscription can be shared with up to 5 people
- If you have Xfinity TV or internet, you can get a bundle with Apple TV+, Netflix, and Peacock for \$15/mo
- \$12.99/mo + free 7-day trial

DISNEY+



Notable titles: All Marvel films and TV shows, Star Wars content, all Disney Pixar + Disney Animated films, concert documentaries

- Selection of film & TV titles owned by Disney (Marvel, National Geographic, ABC, ESPN, etc.) along with Hulu content
- Multiple types of subscriptions and bundles (see link below). Basic is \$12.99/mo with ads

ESPN+



- Access to thousands of live sports shows + exclusive content
- ESPN+ is increasing to \$12.99/mo starting in 2026. The bundle with Disney+ and Hulu will be \$19.99/mo.

HULU



Notable titles: The Bear, Shogun, Only Murders in the Building, The Handmaid's Tale, Abbott Elementary, Futurama, Little Fires Everywhere, The Sopranos

- Film & TV + Hulu originals
- Basic plan with ads is \$11.99/mo, no ads is \$18.99/mo.
- Can be bundled with Disney+, live TV channel access, and more. Info here: <https://help.hulu.com/article/hulu-how-much-does-hulu-cost>

HBO MAX



- Film & TV + HBO Originals
- Films are frequently rotated
- Plans start at \$10.99/mo, can be bundled with Disney+ and Hulu

NETFLIX



- Film & TV + Netflix Originals, new content every week
- Standard plan with ads is \$8.99/mo.

- **Notable titles:** Bridgerton, Stranger Things, Wednesday, K-Pop Demon Hunters, Lucifer, The Queen's Gambit

PARAMOUNT+



- Film & TV + Paramount originals. Can also add Showtime
- Standard plan is \$8.99/mo

- **Notable titles:** NCIS, Survivor, Criminal Minds, Star Trek, Hawaii Five-O, 1883, Halo, Cheers, I Love Lucy

PEACOCK



- Film & TV + Peacock Originals, live news and sports.
- Owned by NBC
- Standard plan with ads is \$7.99/mo.

LIVE TV STREAMING

- DirecTV Stream - most expensive, \$84.99 to \$169/month
- Fubo - \$40 to \$100/month, targets sports fans
- Hulu + Live TV - \$89.99/month with ads, \$99/month without, includes Hulu plus cable channels
- Philo - \$25/month, basically local channels with antenna
- Sling TV - \$45 to \$70/month, offers different packages of channels
- YouTube TV - \$82.99/month, 100+ live channels and major networks, considered best deal right now

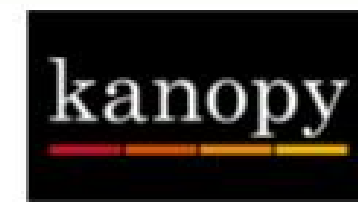

SAVVY TIPS



- The best thing about cutting the cord is that there are no long-term contracts
- Subscribe to what you want, when you want it
- Example:
 - NBA Playoffs = Hulu Live TV, DirecTV Now, Sling TV, or Playstation Vue.
 - Grace & Frankie = Netflix.
- If a show ends and you're done rewatching, cancel the subscription to save \$

Take advantage of free trials – 1 week of binging can save you a lot of money!

Think a la carte! Figure out what you really want to watch and piece together the right combination for you.

WHY STREAM?

- The average cable, internet, & phone bill has risen to \$122/month (Bank of America, 2025).
- Avoid long-term contracts, easy to cancel, can bundle
 - Something to remember: it's always changing
- Can avoid commercials (depending on plans)
- Can still access live TV on some services
- Offline viewing (can download content for on-the-go)
- Personalized recommendations

CONS

- Plans and prices are constantly changing
 - Example: Last time we did this presentation in October 2024, prices were \$5 to \$20 cheaper for EVERY service!
- Services can swap, remove, change shows at their leisure
- Can be difficult to adapt to technology
 - Don't feel pressured to know *everything*
- Many companies no longer allow password sharing
 - Hulu and Disney, notably, require users to be in the same household
