

LIBRARY MILLAGE PROPOSAL 2014

At its March 17 meeting, the Library Committee voted to place on the ballot of the August 5, 2014 primary election a proposal for a .5 library millage for a period of ten years. Successful passage of the millage will qualify our library to join the Suburban Library Cooperative, allowing our patrons to check out items from any of the 21 member libraries and also access to a statewide inter-library loan program. We could join in the Michigan Activity Pass program that offers either free admissions or special discounts to participating museums and cultural attractions throughout the state. Our library would increase its hours and also offer e-books and over 200 emagazines for our patrons. Everyone can help the library by spreading the word to friends and neighbors about the millage proposal and its many benefits, especially as we get closer to the time of the election.


