NEWS FROM THE

DIRECTOR...

On Monday, August 17 Harrison Township Public Library launched *Overdrive*, a service allowing Harrison Township residents the ability to download thousands of ebooks and audiobooks in the popular MP3 format to their computers and mobile devices free of charge. *Overdrive* works with Apple and Android smartphones and tablets, Kindle tablets and ereaders, Windows and Mac computers, Apple iPods and MP3 players, as well as many other devices.



When Harrison Township residents voted in 2014 for a library supported by local tax dollars, they weren't just voting for more open hours, but for a whole array of expanded library services including:

- Membership in the Suburban Library Cooperative: a consortium of 22 libraries in Macomb and Oakland Counties all of which may be used by Harrison Township residents
- Access to MeLCat: a statewide library catalog allowing Harrison Township Residents the ability to request items from hundreds of other Michigan libraries and to have those items delivered to them right here in Harrison Township
- Membership in MLibraryCard, a statewide program allowing Harrison Township residents the ability to borrow printed books in person at 93 other libraries across Michigan
