

### NEWS FROM THE DIRECTOR...

When most people think about their local public library, or any library for that matter, they tend to think only of books. Of equal importance, however, are the many services offered by libraries to their communities.

In August the Harrison Township Public Library expanded its hours from 22 to 40 per week. That's more time not only to stop by and select a book or a movie, but also to use library computers for work or personal business, or to visit with others in your community. Also in August, the Library launched its Overdrive downloadable ebook and audiobook service, allowing our customers to take advantage of Library services on their electronics devices, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. In September the Library reintroduced free programs and classes for Adults on a diverse range of topics. October's free, expert-led, adult class will focus on self-defense.

This October the Library will begin offering a whole new slate of programs for children. "Mother Goose on the Loose" will introduce the smallest among us, ages birth to two years, to the joys of reading and stories. "ABC's of Reading" continues to lay the foundation of literacy for ages three to five years with entertaining finger plays, songs, rhymes, and stories. "Rockin' Readers" is aimed at library customers ages five to eleven and mixes things up with a different theme or genre every week. The first "Rockin' Readers" event on October 10 celebrates a galaxy far, far away with "Star Wars Reads Day". Lastly is "Tales with Tails." Is your young one self-conscious about reading? Then why not have them practice with a furry friend? "Tales with Tails" allows children time to quietly read to an affable, certified service dog who will never judge them.

Here at the Harrison Township Public Library we're pleased to offer these services to our friends and neighbors of all ages. If you have yet to visit us, or perhaps if it has been a while, please consider stopping by...there's a lot happening at your local library!

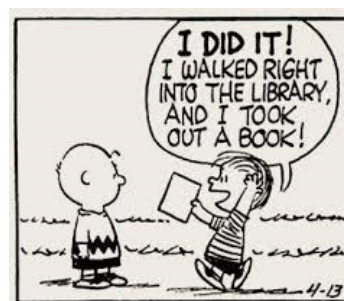

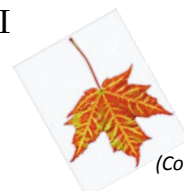
