Don't just TOSS it But TURN it into NEW!

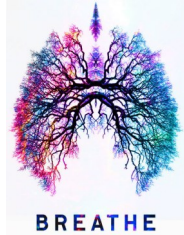
Wednesday, November 1st at 7:00pm

Saturday, November 18th at 1:00pm

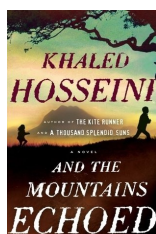
