Vaccines will be given on a first come, first served basis while supplies last. All minor children must be accompanied by a parent or legal quardian.

But then he meets an eccentric young neighbor, Clarisse, who introduces him to a past where people didn't live in fear and to a present where one sees the world through the ideas in books instead of the mindless chatter of television. Montag begins to question everything he has ever known. He starts hiding books in his home, and when discovered, the fireman has to run for his life. In addition to the classic 1966 film, the book has recently been adapted by HBO.
