While participants are responsible for all copays and costs not covered by their insurance, most insurances cover the full amount of the flu vaccine. Influenza is a contagious respiratory illness that spreads from person to person through coughing, sneezing or close contact. Every year in the U.S., millions of people are affected by the flu. Protect yourself and those around you by getting vaccinated. No appointment is necessary. Vaccines will be given on a first come, first served basis while supplies last. All minor children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.

But then he meets an eccentric young neighbor, Clarisse, who introduces him to a past where people didn't live in fear and to a present where one sees the world through the ideas in books instead of the mindless chatter of television. Montag begins to question everything he has ever known. He starts hiding books in his home, and when discovered, the fireman has to run for his life. In addition to the classic 1966 film, the book has recently been adapted by HBO.
