## April Happenings



### ♦ **Wednesday, May 8 at 7pm: DIY Summer Essentials with Renee Pokoj**

### ♦ **Saturday, May 11 at 8:30am - Guided Bird Walk at Lake St. Clair Metropark**

Lake St. Clair Metropark is known as the best birding site in Macomb County. On this library field trip for adults, we will take a guided walk with experts during the height of Spring Migration to look for a variety of unique birds. Dress for the weather, bring binoculars if you have them, and be aware that we will be walking along trails on a wooded chip base.

A shuttle bus will begin boarding at 8:30am to take us to the park for a morning of great birding, rain or shine! The bus will bring us back to the library around 11:30am.

What's a mala you say? It's a strand of 21 to 108 wood or gemstone beads that can be used as an aide in meditation practice.

Participants will receive a basic introduction to the symbolism and proper use of their own strand of beads. Materials, including beads made of eco-friendly wood, are included in the workshop.

### **Series #1: Word Play!**

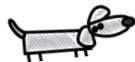
**Dates: 5/4, 5/11, 5/18, 6/1 at 11:30 a.m.**
