## 8. "Long Road to Mercy" by David Baldacci

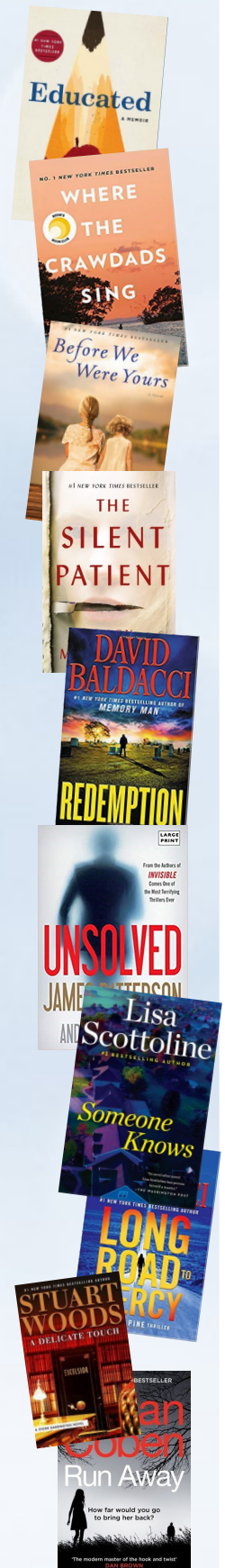
FBI Agent Atlee Pine unravels a rash of missing persons cases in the Grand Canyon.

## 9. "Delicate Touch" by Stuart Woods

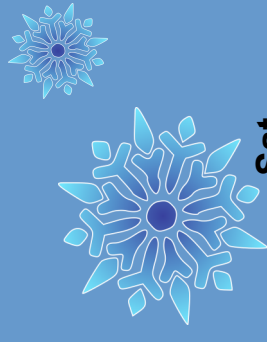
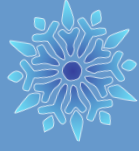
