

Curbside service is easy. Just place your order, wait for notification that your order is ready, and then call us when you're here. We'll deliver your materials to your car with no-contact pickup.

Items can be reserved for pickup by using our online catalog, at catalog.htlibrary.org, or by placing requests by phone with library staff members at (586) 329-1261. Requests may take up to 48 hours to process.






