- 3. Our volunteer delivery drivers will bring your order directly to your home.

Library deliveries are open to all Harrison Township residents with a valid library card. Deliveries cannot be left in common areas. Residents of multiple dwelling facilities like apartments should schedule deliveries when they are able to accept them.
