In November 2022, Harrison Township voters approved a millage proposal that allows the library to extend business hours, expand library programs, upgrade technology, address staff shortages, and create a quiet study space.

With the extension of hours, the library added an additional 19 hours of operation. HTPL is now open earlier for visiting seniors, later for working families, and has more consistent hours that are easier for everyone to remember. Thank you, voters!
