







## You will need:

- Small terracotta pot
- One large white pom-pom (2 in)
- One small white pom-pom (0.5 in)
- White and pink felt
- Hot glue gun
- Paint, color of your choice (optional)
- Greenery or decorations (optional)



Step 2: Glue the smaller pom-pom (the "bunny's tail") to the larger pom-pom (the "bunny's bottom"). If you'd like, you can also secure the larger pom-pom to the front (inside) of the pot.

Step 3: Cut two small ovals out of white felt to your desired size. They should be about one inch or slightly smaller. These are the bunny's feet.

<u>Step 4:</u> You can use pink felt for this step, or you can use pink paint. If you use pink felt, cut small circles and glue small paw prints onto each of the white felt feet. If you use pink paint, paint small paw prints.

<u>Step 5:</u> Glue the completed bunny "feet" onto the rim of the pot. They should be upside down. You can put them close together or far apart.
