

VALENTINE'S PHOTO FRAMES

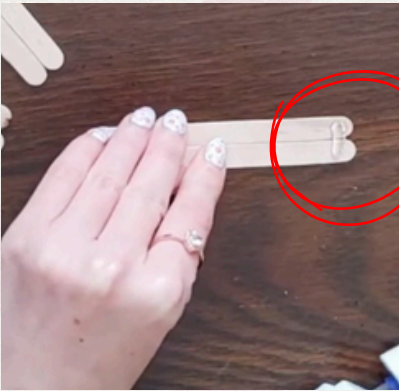
INSTRUCTIONS

You will need:

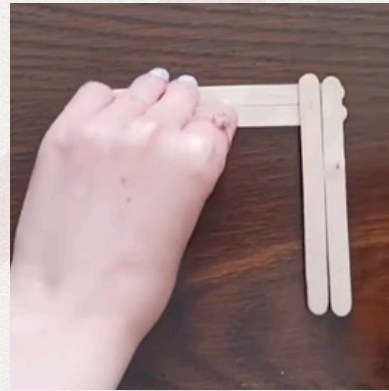
- Popsicle sticks (approx. 8)
- Decorations of your choice (ribbon, stickers, buttons, etc.)
- Hot glue gun
- Paint of your choice (optional)

Step 1: Grab 2 popsicle sticks to act as the top of your frame. Add a line of glue along one edge as pictured below.

Step 2: Grab 1 popsicle stick and adhere it to the line of glue, ensuring it is glued in a straight line to keep the frame square. Repeat the process with a second stick by adding another line of glue next to the first.



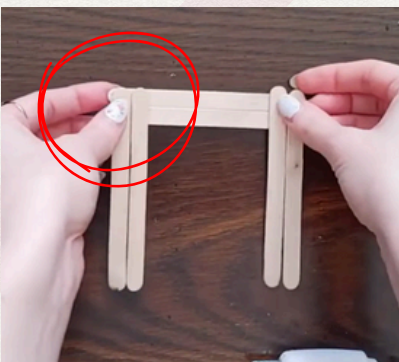

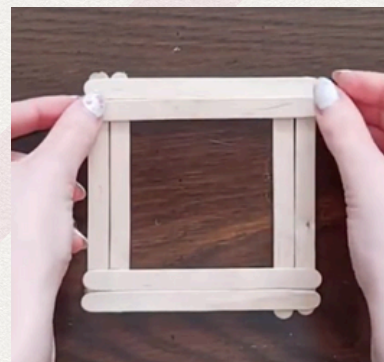

Step 3: Repeat Step 2 but on the other side of the frame.

Step 4: Once you have the other side glued down, flip the frame over and add the two final popsicle sticks to create the bottom of your frame.

Step 5: If you choose to paint your frame, paint the popsicle sticks now. You only have to paint the front side.

Step 6: Add decorations as desired using hot glue to adhere them. If you don't have a hot glue gun, you can try using liquid glue or glue dots for some decorations.

Step 7: Add your photo to the frame by flipping the frame over to the non-painted side. Use small dots of hot glue on all four corners of the frame to adhere the photo, ensuring that the front side of the photo shows through the painted side of the frame.

Step 8: Use your photo frame as a gift, display it in your home, add a magnet to it for your fridge, add string to hang it... the possibilities are endless!
